ADOPTER'S COPY CONTRACT

1. If the cat is removed from my home or confiscated by a third party (including police, city, or county animal care

agency) due to neglected or improper care, I agree that SAFCC may direct the third party to return the animal to SAFCC. SAFCC shall have sole discretion to adopt the cat out to a new home.
2. I will not give the cat away as a gift, resell it, or use it for experimental purposes.
3. I agree to have the cat vaccinated against rabies and licensed according to the ordinances where I reside.
4. I am adopting the cat as indoor only indoor and outdoor outdoor only
5. I will not have the cat declawed.
6. If I am unable to keep the cat for any reason, I will return it to SAFCC.
7. I agree to assume all responsibility for the defense of any action that may arise as a result of my guardianship of this pet and agree to hold SAFCC and its agents and representatives free from any and all liabilities that arise from the conduct of this cat.
8. I understand that SAFCC cannot make any promises or guarantees as to the age, breed, health, habits, or disposition of the cat.
9. I understand that I am financially responsible for all veterinary expenses related to the care of this cat including annual exams, vaccinations, and treatment for any illnesses that cat is found to have.

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
